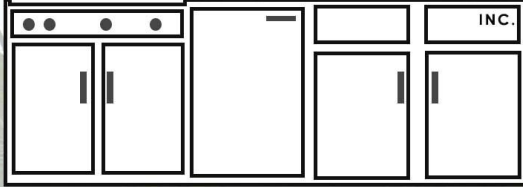

A LA CARTE

Grill Island Inc. will build your kitchen from design ideas to finished product.

We also will help you move through the project in a way that best suites you. We offer what we call our outdoor kitchen A La Carte system. We can separate the process to allow you a choice in building your kitchen in one of three phases.

Phase 1

What's unique about our cabinets is they are framed by welding together aluminum tubing.

Advantages of Aluminum:

- Durability
- Excellent Strength-to-Weight Ratio
- Corrosion Resistant
- Does Not Absorb Moisture
- Resistant to Weather Conditions
- Does Not Rot



Phase 2

The aluminum frame is then enclosed with cement board.

Advantages:

- Designed to last against Cracking, Rotting and Termites.
- Moisture does not cause the board to swell or expand.
- Non-Combustible
- Does not warp
- A floor system is installed for storage. This keeps contents off the ground.
- Composite Decking Board is used for the floor, which is non-porous and totally resistant to rot and insect infection.

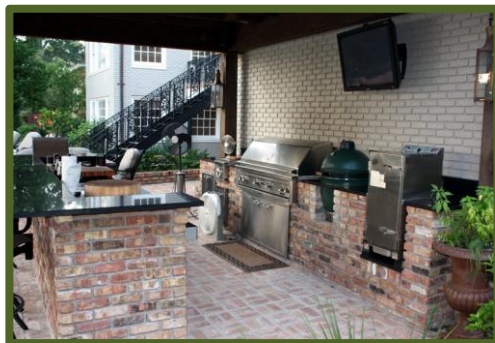
Finishing the Kitchen:

This depends on the design to match the outdoor environment. Custom kitchens can be brick, stucco, stone, tile, Hardisiding, or other preferred finishes.



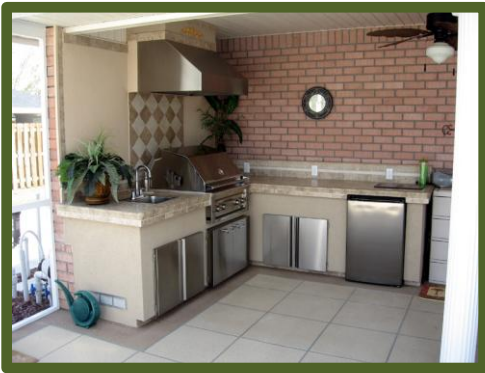
